Be it known that before me Charles Scott a Justice of the peace in and for the County of Boone Kentucky personally appeared Mary Steins a resident of Boone County Kentucky aged Eighty One Years who being first duly sworn according to law doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July of the 1838 Entitled An act granting half pay and pensions to certain soldiers That she is the widow of Hugh Steins who was a private in the Army of the Revolution and was placed on the Pension List roll of the Ohio Agency at the rate of Sixty Seven Dollars & Cts per Annum his Certificate of Pension was dated the 15th July 1838. She further declares that she was married to the said Hugh Steins in Boone County Virginia on the 3rd day of October 1790 and that her husband the aforesaid Hugh Steins died on the 13th day of January 1796 That she was not married to the said Steins before his leaving the Service but the marriage took place previous to the first of January 1794 viz at the time above stated. Dear Madam:

You are advised that it appears from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, W. 6180, that Hugh Steers, or Steirs, while a resident of Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania enlisted August 1, 1781 in Captain Robert Orr's Company, Colonel Archibald Lochrey's Pennsylvania Regiment and on August 24, 1781 was in an engagement with the Indians below the mouth of the Big Miami, was taken prisoner and kept until in 1783 when he was released.

He applied for pension August 8, 1838 while a resident of Boone County, Kentucky aged seventy years. The claim was allowed. He died January 12 or 13, 1846.

Soldier married October 28, 1790 in Ohio County, Virginia, Mary Fowler who was allowed pension on her application executed November 11, 1846 while a resident of Boone County, Kentucky, aged eighty-one years.

There are no further family data on file.

This is the history of the only Hugh Steers, under any spelling of the name, found on the Revolutionary War records of this bureau.
